In April 2003, The Saatchi Gallery opened its doors to the general public. County Hall was selected for the new Gallery because of its prominence on the South Bank, an increasingly important centre for culture and entertainment in the capital.

The 40,000 sq ft contemporary art gallery at London's County Hall exhibits some of the most important contemporary art works in the world. The striking interiors of County Hall, with its magnificent rooms and high ceilings, were paramount in selecting this unique venue as a home for contemporary art and now an event space.

The main Gallery is a unique space in which to hold a reception, sit down dinner or conference and features an impressive, ornate domed ceiling with some of the most infamous pieces by Britain's YBAs.

The present exhibits include works by Damian Hirst, the Chapman Brothers, Tracey Emin, Sarah Lucas and Jenny Saville. The Saatchi Gallery will continue to introduce new artists, invite independent curators to stage one-off shows and host touring programmes from other museums and galleries from abroad.
